Dr. Michael Johannes PILS, 法学博士、弁護士 (Taylor Wessing (ドイツ) 国際法律事務所弁護士)

専門分野：国際取引／企業買収における労働法、ペンション。オクスフォード大学に留学、日本語も話す。

Michael Johannes Pils is a member of the Practice Area Employment and Pensions. His main area of practice is advising companies and executives on all areas of individual and collective employment law, especially on employment-related aspects of M&A transactions and post-merger integrations. A particular focus of his work is on company pension law, remuneration systems, working time models and employee data protection law. Furthermore, he specialises in formulating employment contracts and managing director service agreements.

Michael studied law at the University of Augsburg with a fellowship of German National Academic Foundation until 2004. During his studies and afterwards he worked as scientific assistant (Universities of Augsburg and Bonn). He started to write his dissertation with a fellowship of German National Academic Foundation and was awarded the price of Faculty of Law, University of Augsburg (2009). During his legal training he also studied at the German University of Administrative Science of Speyer (First Prize of DHV) and joined a German international law firm. In 2008 he was awarded a post-graduated fellowship of German Academic Exchange Service for his research at the Institute of European and Comparative Law, University of Oxford.

Sascha Grosjean is member of the Practice Area Employment and Pensions. One substantial part of his work for Taylor Wessing is advising on employment-related aspects of M&A transactions. This also includes advice on HR-matters typically following a transaction (post-merger integration). Besides this he represents management in all aspects of German individual and collective employment law. A particular focus of his work is on company pensions law. Sascha has large experience in advising US and Japanese companies when founding, restructuring or closing their German facilities.

In 1994 and 1997, Sascha passed the two German legal state examinations. He obtained his doctorate in 1998 and joined Taylor Wessing as a partner in 2006.
